Was King Solomon Wise?



Solomon asked God for wisdom and understanding and it was granted. He is thought to have written Proverbs, Song of Solomon and Ecclesiastes. Among his many building projects was the temple, an achievement which eluded his father. David.

Solomon is reported to have 700 wives. Wives were often included as part of treaties. Still I'm not sure there were 700 separate countries and tribes nearby. And treaties would not explain the 300 concubines he also had. This does not seem wise to me or show much understanding. Even if the numbers are somewhat inflated, they indicate someone with a problem.

King Solomon reigned over Israel at its highpoint. The sons who succeeded him were not able to keep the kingdom together. Some biblical authors blame Solomon's foreign wives for his shortcomings. Others claim his building projects were for his vanity rather than the good of the kingdom and that taxes were too high.

The Bible's portrait of Solomon is complex, showing both light and darkness. It is causing me to reflect on leaders that I look up to and those I don't to try to see them as complex persons who like every one of us "does what is evil in the sight of the Lord" as well as reflecting God's Light.
